

## MARKET REPORT - WEEK 30

BASED ON SALES AND PURCHASES OF VESSELS WEEK ENDED FRIDAY 28<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2023.

The war in Ukraine appears almost at stalemate on the land grab or recapture fronts but Ukraine is now admitting to attacking weapons stores and buildings within Russia including even in Moscow, while Russia responds with fresh attacks on Kiev and Odessa having now also withdrawn from the Baltic Sea Grain Initiative which means western vessels attempting to transport Grain from Ukraine's Black Sea ports risk attack or capture by Russian forces. Accordingly, now only Russian ships can masquerade as saviors by transporting their own grains to the many countries that depend on it. Meanwhile Ukraine awaits delivery of the heavy weaponry and munition promised by the US and the West in order to reinvigorate their counter offensive while Russia continues to threaten using nuclear weaponry should Ukraine start to make strong progress.

The Baltic dry freight index (BDI) closed up by 13.5% on Friday but is still only hovering around the 1000 mark as the indexes of the larger size vessels basically yo-yo up a little and down a little on alternate weeks. Last week saw the BCI and BPI close up +26.9% and +5.5% w-o-w respectively, while the BSI and BHSI closed down -4.2% and -1% w-o-w respectively.

S+P volumes are currently subdued for both Bulkers and tankers from the levels they were at 2 or 3 months ago, from when bulker values are now definitely lower while tanker values are proving more resistant to much change.

The general trend of the subcontinent recycling centers in India, Bangladesh and Pakistan remains downbeat due to the lack of ships for sale to them and the lack of demand for steel products domestically, with the added issue of zero LC availability from Pakistani banks and limited availability of same in Bangladesh. Rates theoretically on offer for vessels across the subcontinent fell further for the 4th straight week and now only range from mid \$400s to mid \$500s depending on the type of vessel etc available.
