

MARKET REPORT – WEEK 45

BASED ON SALES AND PURCHASES OF VESSELS WEEK ENDED FRIDAY 8TH NOVEMBER 2024.

The long awaited and much anticipated US Presidential election finally took place last week only to again demonstrate just how wrong most pollsters got it again. This was the election they told us was 'too close to call' but in the end Trump won it by easily and as well as winning the popular vote he also now has control of the Senate, the House or Representatives, and a 6-3 majority of Republican judges in the Supreme Court. That combination will empower Trump to fully stamp his authority, policies and MAGAnomics on the American people domestically, and his will on the world internationally where he has inherited serious problems caused by Russia's war on Ukraine, Iran and its proxies war on Israel, and China's expansionist intentions in the Far East including the annexation of Taiwan. Its going to be an interesting 4 years which are unlikely to be as peaceful as his previous Presidency was during 2017-2021, but hopefully with less court cases pursuing him after his next and last term is completed.

Shipping markets have not yet had time to make any adjustments due to Trump's election success and that will largely only happen over time post his inauguration on 20th January '25 depending on whether he can be successful in ending the conflicts in Ukraine and the middle east and reel in China's world economic influences probably via the use of tariffs. Last week the BDI posted a gain for the first time in 6 weeks by +8.5% however it was due solely to the BCI which managed a w-o-w improvement of 25.3%, while the other 3 dry indexes BPI, BSI and BHSI all closed down by -1.9%, -7.2% and -2.1% respectively.

Second hand tanker sales activity has diminished to very little during recent weeks with owners now actively reducing their price ideas in order to try and attract buyers as they fear values may fall even lower.

Second hand bulker sales are also down on volume, but not as much as for tankers, and in most cases slightly on values too, but seemingly not enough to put off quite a few buyers who are still happy to complete purchases now rather than waiting to see if values fall further.

The recycling market in India appears to have reopened post Diwali festivities with higher demand and rates on offer but it remains to be seen if it leads to the purchase of many vessels and if the levels in the range of about \$450-495 per LDT will be maintained. Bangladesh meanwhile remains less active with low demand and Pakistan is still virtually inactive on ship recycling where cheap imported Chinese steel continues to dominate and influence the domestic market.
